### **Engaging the Word**

### **Engaging the Heart**

1. How have you seen doubt and disbelief as an essential or necessary part of being a follower of Jesus?
2. How can past experiences of God's faithfulness increase our trust in present circumstances?
3. Talk about a time when you felt you were able to take comfort in God's proven character despite current circumstances.

### **Engaging our World**

The Bible gives us permission to doubt. Having doubts is not something to fear. Our faith is strengthened as we push through our doubt and trust in the experiences you've had with God.

As you close in prayer ask God to bring to mind the times that he has been faithful and loving in situations that looked pretty bleak at the time. With this in mind, think of ways that you can be a comfort to others in difficult situations.
